

1. Before beginning the human body project, as a group, submit a plan explaining how you will recreate each of the body systems, i.e.: respiratory, circulatory, digestive, and excretory, for your life-size human body.
2. Create life-size pictures of the body organs from each of the systems. One member of the group will lie on the floor to be traced onto mural paper.
3. To represent the various parts of your organ system, plan to reuse materials from home (e.g. scraps of material, egg cartons, wrapping paper, toilet paper tubes etc.)
4. Be sure to include all of the major parts of your systems (mouth, tongue, teeth, esophagus, stomach, small intestine, and large intestine).
5. Once your project is completed you will present it to the class, ensuring that all members of the group participate. The groups should have 2-3 questions prepared to ask the rest of the class at the close of their presentation.
6. If you are feeling bold, you can add the muscular and skeletal systems as well.
