- 1. Before beginning the human body project, as a group, submit a plan explaining how you will recreate each of the body systems, i.e.: respiratory, circulatory, digestive, and excretory, for your life-size human body.
- 2. Create life-size pictures of the body organs from each of the systems. One member of the group will lie on the floor to be traced onto mural paper.
- 3. To represent the various parts of your organ system, plan to reuse materials from home (e.g. scraps of material, egg cartons, wrapping paper, toilet paper tubes etc.)
- 4. Be sure to include all of the major parts of your systems (mouth, tongue, teeth, esophagus, stomach, small intestine, and large intestine).
- 5. Once your project is completed you will present it to the class, ensuring that all members of the group participate. The groups should have 2-3 questions prepared to ask the rest of the class at the close of their presentation.
- 6. If you are feeling bold, you can add the muscular and skeletal systems as well.
